- Knowing letter names
- Blending /segmenting phonically regular words
- Reading and spelling two/three syllable words

- Reading and discussing non-fiction books
- Making own non-fiction books
- Labelling pictures
- Writing simple sentences/captions
- Naming and describing minibeasts

- Counting in fives/tens
- Halving of groups/numbers

- Capacity
- Weighing - comparing light /heavy

- Recognising and naming a range of minibeasts
