

This topic plan gives you an overview of some of the things that your child will be learning about this term. We hope that this information will help you to support your child's learning at home.

### **Communication, Language and Literacy**

- Consolidation of phonic knowledge particularly digraphs/trigraphs
- Knowing letter names
- Blending / segmenting phonically regular words
- Reading and spelling two/three syllable words
- Reading and writing tricky words
- Handwriting practice
- Shared reading of big books
- Reading and discussing non-fiction books
- Writing instructions/lists
- Writing simple sentences and captions
- Making postcards

- PE: Ball skills and games
- Outdoor play
- Fine motor skills activities e.g. tracing, cutting, threading etc.

### **Mathematical Development**

Ongoing numeracy work including:

- Counting in twos
- Counting in fives

- Ordinal numbers
- Time: o'clock and half past

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

- Painting/drawing pictures of different modes of transport
- Summer related art
- Weekly singing/music activities
- Drama - going on imaginary journeys
- Role-play - Train station

### **Understanding the World**

- Identify different modes of transport
- Sorting different modes of transport e.g. land/sea/air etc
- Discussing road safety
- Making simple maps
- Identifying geographical features of journeys e.g. rivers, mountains etc.
- Comparing old/new forms of transport
- Exploring floating and sinking
- Using construction kits to make different vehicles.
