



# Rewards at Wellington Primary School



Rewards are an integral part of our behaviour policy at Wellington. Staff give 'appropriates' for good behaviour and good learning across the school. Below is an outline of how this is managed in each unit to ensure that the systems are age appropriate.

## Units A and B

### (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)

- Each child has a card which is stamped each time a child receives an appropriate.
- Children need to fill their card (by receiving 60 appropriates) in order to receive a reward in assembly.
- This system is not capped, ensuring that all children will achieve success.
- Children will then start a new card and receive a different reward.
- Rewards include; pencils, badges, books and WH Smith vouchers

## Unit C

### (Year 3 and Year 4)

- Each child has a card which is stamped each time a child receives an appropriate.
- Children need to fill their card (by receiving 60 appropriates) in order to receive a reward in assembly.
- This system is not capped, ensuring that all children will achieve success.
- Children will then start a new card and receive a different reward.
- Rewards include; pencils, badges, books and WH Smith vouchers

## Unit D

### (Year 5 and Year 6)

- Each child is a member of a 'house' - Delius, Hockney, Appleton and Bronte.
- Appropriates count towards 'house points'.
- The house point winner is announced each week in assembly.
- Children collect appropriates and receive a £5 voucher for WH Smith every time they achieve 80 appropriates.
