Our topic is Traditional tales
This half term Year One will be learning...

ENGLISH

We will be learning about three different traditional tales: Jack and the Beanstalk, Little Red Riding Hood and The Three Little Pigs. We will be reading them and writing in lots of different genres.

<u>MATHS</u>

We will begin this year by focussing on 'Number.' We will be reading, writing and counting numbers and objects. We will be learning our number bonds to make 5 and 10. The children will begin ordering numbers and adding two numbers together and subtracting.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about growing plants, in particular we will be growing beanstalks to help Jack!

GEOGRAPHY

We will be using maps to help Little Red Riding Hood find her way through the forest. We will be looking at simple compass directions.

R.E

We will be looking at books that are special, reflecting on the meanings (or 'morals') in stories, including secular tales and fables. We will go on to investigate special books and writings for religious believers, in particular the Bible and the Qur'an.

<u>D.T.</u>

We will be designing a house for character and then making a model of it for them!

PSHE

We will be thinking about physical health and wellbeing. We will learn about food that is associated with special times in different cultures. Look at playground games from around the world and also about sun-safety.

COMPUTING

We will be learning what technology is and how we use it. We will learn the different parts of a computer and how to log on to the computers independently.

PE

This half term we will be doing a gymnastics unit and in our Games lessons, we will be developing ball control skills.

MUSIC

We will be exploring beat and rhythm in a variety of songs.
