**We hope you have had a good holiday.**

**Our topic this half term is 'The Seaside and Under the Sea'.**

This half term Year One will be learning...

### English

Our English work will cover both poetry and fiction texts. We will be writing about stories we have read and writing our own stories. We will also be writing recounts linked to our visit to Scarborough. We will continue with our ongoing phonics work and reading activities.

### Maths

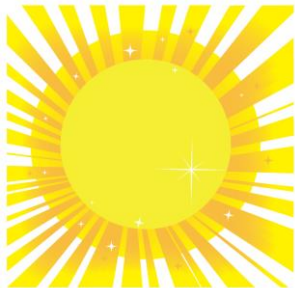
In Maths we will be learning about place value in numbers to 100. We will be learning about money and measures as well as continuing to develop our knowledge of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

### Science

We will be learning about materials, including thinking about how to sort them and what materials are suitable for different purposes. We will be carrying out investigations linked to our seaside topic.

### Geography

We will be learning about the physical and human features of the seaside and looking at where Scarborough and Bradford are on a map of the UK.

We will continue with our topic called Special Places

### Art

We will be looking at seaside art by famous artists. We will be creating artwork in the style of these artists.

### History

We will be learning about what seaside holidays were like in the past compared to now.

### PSHE

We will be thinking about how to live a healthy lifestyle and which foods we need to eat to stay healthy.

### Computing

We will be completing our Visual Media unit, a unit about Sound and Music and then we will complete a Digital Literacy unit.

### P.E.
