Welcome back after the Half Term break.

Topic

Fairy Tales

This half term Year One will be learning...

ENGLISH

We will be learning about three different traditional tales: Jack and the Beanstalk, Little Red Riding Hood and The Three Little Pigs. We will be reading them and writing in lots of different genres.

MATHS

We will be learning about addition and subtraction and ordinal numbers as well as exploring shape and pattern.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about growing plants, in particular we will be growing beanstalks to help Jack!

GEOGRAPHY

We will be using maps to help Little Red Riding Hood find her way through the forest. We will be looking at simple compass directions.

R.E.

We will continue to look at things that are special to people in different religions.

D.T.

We will be designing a house for a fairytale character and then making a model of it for them!

P.S.H.E.

We will be thinking about living in a multicultural society, in particular, the clothes that people wear for different celebrations.

COMPUTING

We will be continuing our work on 'Control' using a range of programmes to develop the children's mouse control skills.

P.E.

This half term we will be developing our skills in gymnastics.

MUSIC

We will be exploring beat and rhythm in a variety of songs, themed around the traditional tales we have been studying.

READING

Please try to read with your child every night, if possible. Please can you sign in their red reading record book to say they have read with you (comments are optional) and write the title of the book. Your child can then change their reading book themselves the next morning. If your child has read at home they will earn themselves an appropriate every time and earn points to collect stickers and certificates.
