Our topic this half term will be Space.

This half term Year One will be learning...

English

Our English work will cover fiction work based on a number of Space fiction books. We will be retelling stories, writing our own stories and writing letters in role. We will be acting out stories and doing a range of drama activities to support our writing. We will be making Space Dictionaries and writing exciting Space poems.
