Our topic this half term is 'The Seaside and Under the Sea'.

This half term Year One will be learning...

English

Our English work will cover both poetry and fiction texts. We will be writing about stories we have read and writing our own stories. We will also be writing recounts linked to our visit to Scarborough. We will continue with our ongoing phonics work and reading activities.

Maths

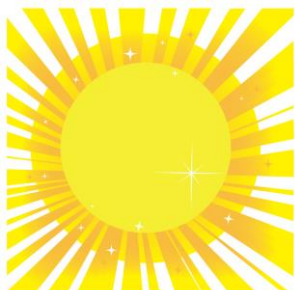
In Maths we will be learning about place value in numbers to 100. We will be learning about telling the time to the hour and half hour, money and measures as well as continuing to develop our knowledge of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

Science

We will be learning about materials, including thinking about how to sort them and what materials are suitable for different purposes. We will also be carrying out investigations linked to our seaside topic and the seasons of the year.

Geography

We will be learning about the physical and human features of the seaside and looking at where Scarborough and Bradford are on a map of the UK.
