

Reading

Try to read with your child every night, if possible. Please can you sign in their red reading record book to say they have read with you (comments are optional) and write the title of the book. Your child can then change their reading book themselves the next morning. If your child has read at home then they will earn themselves an appropriate every time! They will also get a tick on their reading reward chart. Some children have read 50 books and have received their bronze reading certificate – well done! Some of the books are longer than others so if your child has read a few pages please make a note of the pages and your child will still get an appropriate.

Homework

As well as reading with your child, please continue to support your child with their Learn By Heart maths and spellings homework. We are always happy to see stories and extra research from your child if they want to do this at home. The spelling test and LBH Maths test will now be every Friday. New spellings will also be given out on a Friday.

Please make sure that your child keeps their LBH maths homework book and blue spelling book in their book bag. Thank you.

PE

This term Year Two will be learning...

English and History

We are learning about the Great Fire of London within our English and History lessons. The children are going to read and research information about the fire and we will be writing our own non-fiction booklets and poems. We will be learning about Samuel Pepys and writing our own Great Fire of London diaries as well as finding out about what living conditions were like at the time.

This half term we have an exciting workshop booked. The children will make their own Tudor house out of a box and then we will recreate Pudding Lane on the school field and set the boxes alight!

Maths

In Maths we will be revisiting addition and subtraction, working with numbers up to 100. We will be looking at money and how different combinations of coins make different values. We will continue to work on multiplication and division including solving word problems. Please continue to help your child learn 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will test the children to see if they can get their times tables certificate! Your child should have a log on for the Times Tables rock stars website (www.trockstars.com)

Science

Over the half term the children will learn about animals. We will look at different types of animals and how we classify them. We will explore how animals grow and mature into adults. We will be working scientifically to gather and record information about different animals.

D.T.

The children are going to make a wheeled vehicle. We will look at a variety of vehicles and design and make one.

Art

Over the half term we will paint some Tudor houses.

R.E

Our work will focus on different special days that are important in different religions. This will include Mothering Sunday and Easter.

PSHE

We will discuss different relationships and the different choices we should make. We will think about right and wrong choices and begin to think about choices involving money.

Computing

We will be creating a multimedia presentation about the Great Fire of London. We will use Textease to paint, copy and paste, add text and sound to our presentations. We will then improve our work by changing the font size and colour and by editing picture layout and size.

P.E

Skipping

Children will be taking part in a skipping unit. Children will learn how to skip on their own and using a long rope. Children who are unable to skip will begin learning the basic skills of rope turning and jumping to begin developing their balance and co-ordination. More able children will begin learning simple skipping skills and challenges and start to link them together.

Tag rugby

This half term Year 2 Children will be introduced to tag rugby, in which they will be developing their teamwork, footwork and movement skills.
