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This parents' topic plan is designed to inform you of the work that your child will be covering this half term and to enable you to support him/her in these areas at home.

English

We will read extracts from the novel "The Twits" by Roald Dahl. We will focus on describing characters and settings and writing diary entries.

Science Plants

We will be learning about the parts of flowering plants and their functions. We will investigate the conditions affecting plant growth and look at plant life cycles, in particular how seeds are formed, dispersed and germinate.

We will learn how to use search engines and child friendly websites, to find key information to complete research tasks. We will also identify how web pages are organised.

Being a Good Member of the Community

We will learn what a community is and explore the different communities that we are part of. We will think about how people behave and the importance of rules.

French

Je Parle Français

We will be learning how to greet each other, ask about how we are, and reply. We will also learn to say our names and ages.

Geography

Passport to France and Spain

We will be learning about the landscape, weather and culture of both France and Spain. We will use a range of maps, data, pictures and photos to support our research.

R.E.

Special Places

Over the next term, we will be learning about special places for different religions. This half term we will focus on the Gurdwara and learn about what people do there.

P.E

Outdoor and Adventurous

Children will develop their communication through participation in a range of orienteering activities. They will develop map reading skills and learn how to follow instructions to complete a range of outdoor challenges and orienteering based tasks.

Hockey

Children will develop their balance, agility and co-ordination by participating in a range of mini-hockey skills, drills and games. They will start to understand how to use teammates when playing games and begin to develop attacking and defending skills.

Art

Investigating Pattern

We will be looking at patterns around us and also those used in textiles and wall coverings from different times and cultures. We will use stencilling and printing techniques and we will also present shapes, colours and patterns to produce finished individual designs.

Singing Games

We will be learning different singing games, which involve different rhythmic patterns and tempo. We will also compose and perform some of our own.

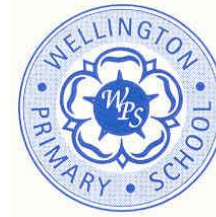
Homework is given out on Friday and is due back in on Tuesday.
