**This parents' topic plan is designed to inform you of the work that your child will be covering this half term and to enable you to support him/her in these areas at home.**

#### **English**

We will read extracts from the novel "The Magic Finger" by Roald Dahl. We will focus on writing stories using dialogue and writing non-chronological reports.

#### **Maths**

#### **Forces**

We will be learning about attraction and repulsion between magnets and which materials are attracted to magnets. We will be investigating different types of forces and how objects start and stop movement.

#### **Computing Programming With Textease Turtle & Scratch**

We will use Textease Turtle to write instructions to create 2D shapes and 2D shape art work using different artist's work for inspiration.

#### **P.S.H.E. Living in a Multicultural and Multi-faith Community**

We will be exploring the similarities and differences in communities that we are part of. We will develop our understanding of respect and the importance of appreciating everyone around us.

#### **French Je Parle Français (contd.)**

We will be learning how to say how old we are. We will also learn the words for classroom items.

## **History & Geography**

### **Our Local Area**

We will be learning about our local area, in the past. We will be finding out about Bradford mills in the past and about the impact of Victorian mills. We will be learning about a part of Bradford's history: the tragic fire at Valley Parade. We will use a range of maps, data, pictures and photos to support our research.

### **R.E.**

#### **Special Places**

Over the next term, we will be learning about special places for different religions. This half term we will focus on the Synagogue and Church, learning more about what people do there.

### **P.E**

#### **Games – Netball & Basketball Skills**

Children will be learning the skills to play small sided netball and basketball type games. They will begin to develop basic attacking and defending skills and start to use tactics to influence the outcome of a game.

#### **Indoor - Gymnastics**

Children will work as part of a small group to create a floor routine involving a range of key shapes, jumps and leaps, rolls and balances. They will understand the importance of body control and will develop their rhythm and timing when putting their actions to the beat of a song.

### **D.T.**

#### **Photograph Frames**

We will be looking at the stability of structures and different design elements so that we can use what we have learned to produce a functional and aesthetically pleasing photograph frame.

### **Music**

#### **Animal Magic**

We will be looking at how animals are portrayed in music and how accompanying movements can bring the animals to life.
