

We are providing provision for children due to start Reception in September on the week beginning 7<sup>th</sup> September in Nursery in the following ways:

- If your child attended Wellington Nursery for 30 hours then this provision will be available during this week. Your child will then start Reception on 14<sup>th</sup> September on a full-time basis.
- If your child attended Wellington Nursery for morning sessions then this provision will be available during this week. Your child will then start Reception on 14<sup>th</sup> September with the first three days being mornings only (8.35-11.45).
- If your child attended Wellington Nursery for afternoon sessions then this provision will be available during this week. Your child will then start Reception on 14<sup>th</sup> September with the first three days being afternoons only (12.45-3.15).
- If your child attended an alternative Nursery setting then you will be allocated a morning or afternoon slot for this provision. Details will be on the compliment slip inside your booklet. Your child will then start Reception on 14<sup>th</sup> September part-time for the first three days for their allocated session.
  - All children will then be in school full time from 17<sup>th</sup> September.
